

PERSONAL DATA

The legal processing of the personal data is important for UVMP and its protection is a matter of course. We would like to inform you about processing your personal data in connection with new Act no.18/2018 Coll. On the Protection of Personal Data and on Amendments to Certain acts, (hereinafter referred to as 'Act').

When processing your personal data, we take care of the principles:

- legality of processing (§ 6 Act),
- restriction of the purpose (§ 7 Act),
- minimization of personal data (§ 8 Act),
- correctness (§ 9 Act),
- minimization of storage (§ 10 Act),
- integrity and confidentiality (§ 11 Act),
- confidence (§ 12 Act).

List of personal data: *individual person:* name and surname, degree, email address
company: firm name, street and number, city, post code, state.

Purpose for the processing of your personal data:

- registration of conference participants and payment of attendance fees;
- keeping a database of conference participants database for the purpose (based on your agreement) sending of electronic circulars of the conference, email marketing messages and invitations to events organized by UVMP.

Legal basis of the processing your personal data:

- Act no. 513/1991 Coll. Commercial Code subsequently amended;
- Civil Code no. 40/1964 Coll. subsequently amended;
- § 13 par. 1 letter. b) Act no. 18/2018 Coll. On the Protection of Personal Data and on Amendments to Certain Acts.

Time of retention of the personal data:

- **10 years** in the sense of Internal regulation no. 65 – The Registry Code UVMP;
- erasure is possible upon the written request of the concerned person .

The concerned person, whose personal data the operator process has the right through the responsible person to process his or her personal data:

- to demand from the operator access to personal data of particular affected person;
- to rectify personal data;
- to erasure personal data or restrict the processing of personal data of the person concerned (if possible);
- to object to the processing of personal data;
- to accuracy;
- to withdraw consent to the processing of personal data (if possible);
- to file a complaint to Office For Personal Data Protection in the sense § 100 Act.
